



CLASS OF 2007 HIGHLIGHTS

- Pursued admission at 95 different schools in 23 states and will attend 24 different colleges and universities in 11 states
- 13% of the class qualified for the Palmetto Fellows Scholarship, South Carolina's premier academic scholarship program
- 75% of the class qualified for the Life Scholarship
- The class was offered \$2.5 million in college merit scholarship awards
- Two seniors were named National Merit Finalists
