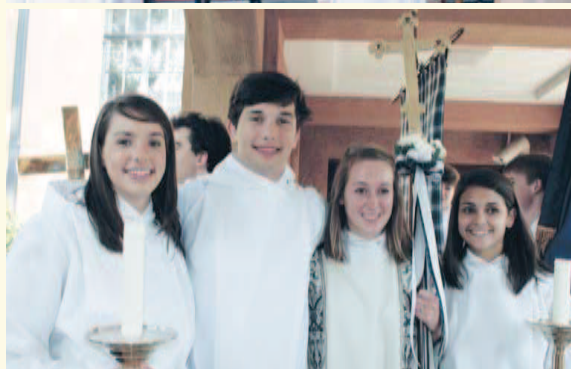


On May 29, Heathwood Hall Episcopal School graduated 68 students at Averyt Hall at Trinity Cathedral.
