Policy for weddings: Congratulations on your engagement! This is a very exciting time and Heathwood Hall wants to wish you many blessings on your journey. We welcome Christian weddings at the Chapel of the Epiphany. Those from Christian traditions other than Episcopal Church may request use of The Chapel of the Epiphany by contacting Rev. Jill Williams at <a href="mailto:jwilliams@heathwood.org">jwilliams@heathwood.org</a> to secure your wedding date. Please include the name of the pastor or officiant for service.

Episcopal weddings on campus will follow <u>The Order of Marriage</u> as found in the Book of Common Prayer. Rev. Jill Williams or another local Episcopal Clergy is welcome to serve as the officiant of your service. Simply email Rev. Jill Williams to secure your date, learn about the fee for use of the Chapel or campus, and indicate who you would like to perform the service. Please note that Rev. Jill Williams is not available for the mandatory premarital counseling, but she will help you find a counselor or a priest to do the work of preparing you for marriage.

**Policy for Baptisms:** The Episcopal Church sees baptism as both a promise to follow the ways of Jesus Christ and as a welcome into the community of believers that will support you on this journey. As such we encourage you to seek Baptism at your local Epsicopal Parish. However, we recognize that Christians have varied Baptismal traditions.
