# Information for New to Heathwood Families

How can my child get to know some classmates over the summer?

- Contact information for new students was shared with the parents of returning students serving as student ambassadors the first week of June. **Student Ambassadors** in grades 6th 8th are current Heathwood students who will reach out to new students over the summer to help facilitate social interactions, nurture friendships, and answer questions.
- Since all **5th graders** are new to the Middle School, we host a special orientation for all 5th graders and their parents in August.

When is orientation for new students? When can my child set up his/her locker?

- Save the date! Orientation and locker set-up for ALL 5th-grade students and their parents (both new and returning families) will be held on Monday, August 11th from 1:00-3:00pm in the 2nd-floor Commons Area of the Nord Middle School building. We will share more information as the date approaches.
- Orientation and locker set-up for ALL new-to-Heathwood 6th-8th grade students and their parents will be held on Tuesday, August 12th, from 8:30-10:30am in the 1st-floor Commons Area of the Nord Middle School building.

## How do I find out information about my child's schedule?

- **Schedules for new students** will be shared at orientation. All Middle School students will receive a note from their advisor before orientation and locker set-up.
- Class schedules are created for each student based in part on math placement and world language choices.
- No electives need to be chosen for 5th-6th Grade students; all students rotate through all related arts classes.
- **7th Grade and 8th Grade** students have already chosen their year-long performing arts courses. They will also rotate through PE, Strength & Conditioning (8th Grade), Religion (7th Grade), MakerSpace, Visual Art, and PEAK classes. Students will have yearlong study halls.

## Information for All Middle School Families

## Where do we locate summer reading, math packets, supply lists, and the Handbook?

- All items related to summer reading requirements, math packet assignments, supply lists, etc. are posted on the <a href="Back-to-School page">Back-to-School page</a>.
- The updated Student/Parent Handbook and the Middle School Curriculum Guide will be published later in the summer.

### How do students sign up for and try out for athletics?

- To participate in athletics, students must register on <u>Family ID</u>.
- Once registered, students will receive information about summer practices.

### How do I know my child's schedule?

- Class schedules are created for each student based in part on math placement and world language choices.
- **Returning Middle School** students in grades 6-8 will receive a copy of their schedule on the first day of school and be able to access an electronic version of their schedule on PlusPortals after the eCampus bookstore opens later this summer.

## When is the locker set-up time for returning students?

• Locker set-up for all returning students in grades 6-8 will be on Tuesday, August 12th, from 12:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. (drop-in). Please do not arrive after 3:30pm.

#### How do we order our books?

• The **Virtual Bookstore** is what families use to purchase consumables and rent textbooks for the school year. The Virtual Bookstore will be populated with the specific textbooks, workbooks, and novels that your child will need based on his or her schedule. The target date for the bookstore going live is July 1, and you will receive more information and instructions later this month.

## First Day of School and Advisory

- Faculty will mail notes to students in their Advisory during the first week of August welcoming them to the upcoming new school year. School begins on Wednesday, August 13 at 8:10 am and dismisses at 12:00 pm.
- School will operate during normal hours from 8:10 am to 3:05 pm on Thursday and Friday, August 14-15. Middle School students will follow special altered schedules on those days to facilitate orientation activities and introductory sessions of all of their classes.
- The first day of the normal rotating daily schedule will be on Monday, August 18.

#### **Dress Code Information & Plaid Peddler Summer Hours**

- Please review the <u>Middle School Dress Code</u> and take note of any updates. We appreciate your
  assistance in supporting our efforts to establish a school environment that supports teaching and
  learning. In particular, please see the section regarding outerwear. We ask that students do not
  wear any hoodie, sweatshirt, or sweater that is not a Heathwood logo garment. We do not
  consider these garments outerwear.

- The summer hours for **The Plaid Peddler** are as follows: June 1st July 18th open 9:00 am-1:00 pm and by appointment in the afternoon until 4:00 pm.
